Entire Home

Cleaning tools required:

Vacuum cleaner
Mop with bucket
Pails and wash basin
Microfiber cleaning cloth
Mirror & glass cleaning cloth

Protective cleaning gloves
Window blind brush cleaner
Extendable & bendable duster
Upholstery cleaning machine
Anti-dust mite mattress vacuum

Cleaning solutions required:

Floor cleaner

Antibacterial all-purpose cleaner

Bathroom

Cleaning tools required:

Toilet bowl scrub
Bathroom tiles sponge scrub
Sink sponge scrub
Squeegee wiper
Mirror & glass cleaning cloth
Cleaning brush for grout
Floor scrub

Cleaning solutions required:

Toilet bowl cleaner
Tile and grout cleaner
Glass and mirror cleaner

Kitchen

Cleaning tools required:

2 x Microfiber cleaning cloth
(one for wiping, one for drying)
Scrubbing sponge
Cleaning brush for kitchen hob

Cleaning solutions required:

Antibacterial all-purpose cleaner
Stovetop cleaner
Oven cleaner
Stainless steel cleaner / baking soda
Rust and lime scale remover
